The organiser has a right to split the categories into groups if the number of participants requires it.



Entries

All clubs and members of national figure skating federations associated with the ISU are invited to take part in the competition. Each club has the right to enter competitors in any category and class. The organiser reserves the right to limit the number of participants should the number of entries be too high; therefore the clubs are asked to list the skaters in the order in which they wish to be accepted to the competition. The organising club has the right to enter more participants than other clubs.

Finnish club's entries must be submitted using Taikkari and others by email easterskate2026@gmail.com by February 28th 2026.

Please note that all skaters from outside Finland are guaranteed entry.

Confirmation and preliminary schedule

Preliminary schedule (subject to change) will be available on competition website. Confirmation and the final schedule with details will be published on March 9th 2026.

Entry Fees

Categories with ISU evaluation, only one program 66 €

Categories with ISU evaluation, two programs 100 €

We kindly ask the clubs to make one payment transaction for all participants. Please include the name of your club in the payment details. In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. Participating clubs are asked to immediately inform the organiser of any changes in their entries by e-mail to easterskate2026@gmail.com

Cancellations

According to Finnish Skating Union regulations (chapter 15.7), for foreign competitors, cancellations after the confirmation will not be refunded for any reason but their club may substitute them with another skater in the same category.

Draw

The draw will be held at 6pm on March 20th. The draw will be made by FSM program. The result of the draw will be published on the competition website by latest on March 21st, 2026.

Awarding

Three first standings of each category/class will be awarded with a cup. Award ceremonies will be held as soon as the results are confirmed. ISU protocols will be posted on the organisers website and will not be mailed to participants after the event.

Judges
